International Lunch Follows the Service

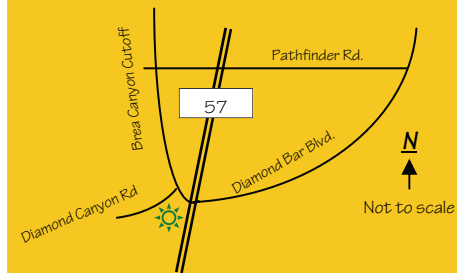
